Following a day of touring you'll enjoy DINNER at Tony & Joe's on the waterfront in Georgetown and an evening illumination tour of our capital city, showcasing the memorials and monuments.

Day 3 Enjoy a delicious BREAKFAST this last morning in D.C. before attending the Parade of the National Cherry Blossom Festival from our grandstand seats, the best vantage point for this spectacular event of Marching Bands, Dance and drumming performance and the Cherry Blossom Queens from the US and Japan add royalty to the procession. An exciting tradition to welcome Spring! This afternoon our group will board the tram tour to visit the Arlington National Cemetery, Tomb of the Unknowns and the "Changing of the Guard" ceremony.
